Highways

Finger signs are in need of cleaning.

(b) Bay Horse Corner – Update from Cllr Snowden following site visit by ERYC highways 362/20
A site visit was arranged with highways, Cllr Snowden and Cllr Woodward.
ERYC said it would not convert the road layout back to how it was, as this would create a speed way.
The road signage around the corner was checked and confirmed to be adequate.
Even though traffic accidents have occurred, they are only recorded with ERYC if someone is injured.

Community Speed Watch Group – To receive an update 364/20
Following correspondence from the police, all speed watch activities have been suspended until further notice due to the current Covid restrictions.

Road monitoring on Driffield Road – Cllr Horner 365/20
Driffield Road has been highlighted by Community Speed watch as a concern for speeding traffic, a request from the police has been submitted for a speed radar presences.

Correspondence was received from the trustees of 'Love Driffield' who had been tasked by ERYC to prepare emergency boxes for each parish. A councillor has kindly agreed to collect and store the boxes. These are to distributed to the most needy in the village.
