ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
Part of North Back Lane, Kilham

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along part of North Back Lane, Kilham between the junctions of Burton Road and Thwing Road, commencing 1st August 2022 until 02nd September 2022 to allow for carriageway resurfacing works.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 40 days.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Burton Road, East Street, Church Street, Middle Street, Chapel Lane, West End, Langtoft Road, Back Lane, North Back Lane, Kilham CP, East Wolds and Coastal Ward

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians.
