## **Support Group Coffee Morning**

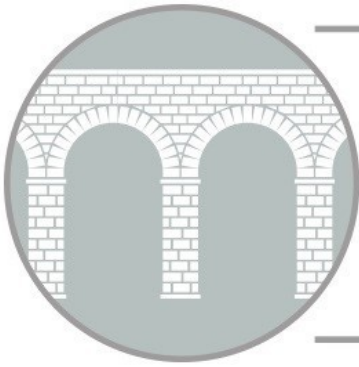
All Saints' Church, Kilham, will be hosting a Coffee Morning with a difference between 10:00 - 11:30am, on Saturday, 6th July.
