Kilham Parish Council

Following a bid through ERYC "Do it for Yorkshire" grant, the Parish Council was successful in securing £3,700. With the funds we have purchased for the village two new benches, a sturdy picnic bench, various plants and shrubs, a number of wildlife/bird boxes and some new KPFA signposts.

As you will be aware there was a car incident on East Street a few months ago which destroyed the bench outside the church and its surrounds, unfortunately the person responsible did not come forward and have the decency to offer to replace the bench so the Parish Council has had to claim for the damages through their insurance company. We have now received a new bench and this will be put in place shortly.

Wrap Around Care:

The school recently became aware that a few local village families have made the decision to go to other local schools because both parents worked and struggled with after-school care. We are now pleased to announce that from September 2022 we will be able to offer an Afternoon Out-of-School Club until 5.30 pm, for all children from Reception to Year 6. This is in addition to the fabulous After School Clubs we already provide such as gym, football and craft, so children may attend both, or either, on any one evening between Monday and Friday each week of the school term.

One of our current teams will be running the Afternoon Club so children will be familiar with them. Times of attendance and different charging options are available to help those who want an extra half hour of school care as well as those who require longer care. We will provide children staying after school with a drink and a snack but you will need to provide them with a meal once you return home.
